

FDI Fastener Distributor Index

Report Based on Monthly Distributor Input

The Fastener Distributor Index has been developed by The FCH Sourcing Network in conjunction with the NFDA (National Fastener Distributor Association) and data is analyzed by David J. Manthey, CFA of R.W. Baird to measure the operating conditions and sentiment within the North American industrial fastener distributor sector. The FDI is compiled monthly from survey input provided by qualified distributors. Results are published on Fully Threaded Radio by Mike McNulty of Fastener Technology International Magazine. A historical graph of the index is provided below.

The seasonally adjusted Fastener Distributor Index (FDI) for May was 45.0, showing signs of recovery as states began reopening and some manufacturing/construction customers resumed operations. Sales trends on a seasonally adjusted basis improved m/m, albeit off a very low base. The sixmonth outlook also improved to a more normalized level. Net, conditions remain very weak but are showing signs of improving, potentially signaling April was the bottoming in activity level for most participants.

The seasonally adjusted FLI increased to 43.9, a sharp uptick from last month's 36.2. Respondents are on balance once again feeling more optimistic than pessimistic about the six month outlook, while employment has also started to return to more normal levels.

The FDI has been developed as a service to the fastener industry and to the wider business community it serves. All survey data collected is maintained in strict confidence and is compiled for publication in index form by **R.W. Baird & Co.** No information collected or compiled through the **FDI** monthly survey is shared, sold or otherwise used outside the scope of the index.

Registered users receive email reminders at the start of each open survey period.

Anything above 50 indicates growth, below 50 is retraction. The seasonally adjusted May FDI (45.0) increased from the previous month, April (41.5). 

The Manufacturing ISM Report On Business® is based on data compiled from purchasing and supply executives nationwide. Survey responses reflect the change, if any, in the current month compared to the previous month. For each of the indicators measured (New Orders, Backlog of Orders, New Export Orders, Imports, Production, Supplier Deliveries, Inventories, Customers' Inventories, Employment and Prices), the report shows the percentage reporting each response, the net difference between the number of responses in the positive economic direction and the negative economic direction, and the diffusion index. A PMI™ reading above 50 percent indicates that the manufacturing economy is generally expanding; below 50 percent indicates that it is generally declining.
