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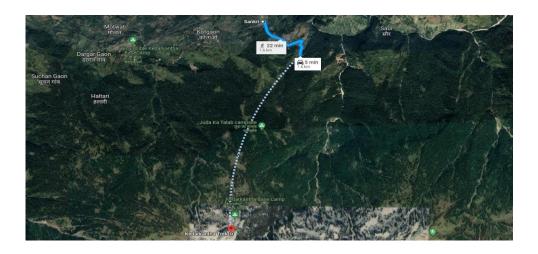
## Kedarkantha Trek

### Winter Trek to Kedarkantha in Garhwal Himalayas. Uttarakhand INDIA

Kedarkantha is considered as one of the most liked winter climbing region of Uttarakhand, India at an altitude of 12500 feet, It is the most satisfying trek for the people of all ages. The mesmerizing and extraordinary views of the entire mountain range and the meadows keep one spellbound. Kedarkantha is an inconceivable spot to remain there and partake in the dawn and dusk. The Trek is an exemplary winter journey gives an extraordinary open door to travelers to investigate a novel, new thing about the nature, and experience the existence of distant towns of Garhwal Himalayas..

#### The view from the Kedarkantha Summit

Be it Swargarohini Peak -I. II.III (6300 meters), Black Peak (6387 meters), Bandarpunch Peak (6300 meters), one can have a majestic view all these Snow peaked Himalayan Ranges from Kedarkantha Peak. Mountains and passes like Rupin pass range, Supin range, Khimloga Peak, Baraadsar Lake range, Vishkhopri range, Ranglana Peak 5800 meters, etc can also be viewed during the Kedarkantha Peak Climb.

#### **DETAILED ITINERARY**

## **DAY 01: Dehradun - Sankri (1900 m) Drive 193Km (7-8Hrs)**

Post breakfast depart for Sankri. Lunch enroute at Local Restaurant. Arrival at Sankri in the afternoon. Rest of the day free for acclimatization in Sankri. Overnight stay at the hotel.

**Meals:** Breakfast + Lunch + Dinner | Stay: Sankri

Day 02: Sankri - Juda Ka Talab (2700m) (Trek 4 kms/4½ hrs) - Gujjar Hut Today morning after breakfast we will check out from the hotel and begin our trekking to reach Juda Ka Talab. Cross the village Saur and the road takes a wide curve. Later climb sharply to next to a stream. The trail gets into the pine forest and starts to climb sharply until you reach a ridge after few minutes later. On the ridge the trail evens out and widens for almost the rest of the day. Arrive at Juda Ka Talab. Set up our Camp. Rest of the day to enjoy the serenity of the place. This pond freezes into solid ice during winters. We continue on the trail and the views get really exciting as we start to get a glimpse of the tips of the snow capped peaks of the Himalayas. Overnight stay in tents.

**Meals:** Breakfast + Lunch/Packed Lunch + Dinner | Stay: Tents

## Day 03: Juda Ka Talab/Gujjar Hut - Kedar Kantha Base (Trek 4 km/4 hrs)

After breakfast start trek to Kedar Kantha Base. The route is beautiful with vast fields of snow and patches of green in between them. Views are open on all sides and will keep one busy with the camera. It is going to be an exhausting but enjoyable hike today. The Kedar Kantha base or campsite is a vast open snow ground of the size of two football fields surrounded by misty mountains from all sides and a stream running nearby. From nearby we get fabulous views of Swargarohini, Bandarpoonch & Kalanag peaks. Overnight in Tented Camp.

**Meals:** Breakfast + Lunch/Packed Lunch + Dinner | Stay: Tents

## Day 04: Kedar Kantha Base - Kedar Kantha Peak (12,500 ft) – Hargaon (Trek 9 **Km/6-7hrs**)

The distance to the summit is not long but is reasonably steep and depending upon the snow conditions we will select the route leading to the summit. It will take anywhere between 2 to 3 hours to get to the top. The views are outstanding from the summit. You get to see all the mountains of the Yamunotri and Gangotri range and also of Kinner Kailash range and other ranges in



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Himachal. Also there are some great views of the underlying valleys. After spending sometime at the top we will start descending and walk all the way down to Sankri. On arrival at Sankri check in at your hotel. Dinner and overnight

**Meals:** Breakfast + Lunch/Packed Lunch + Dinner | Stay: Tents

#### Day 05: Hargaon - Sankri (6Km)

Today after a relaxed breakfast we begin with the last leg of our trek. On arrival at Sankri check in. Evening we will explore the local market of Sankri.

**Meals:** Breakfast + Lunch/Packed Lunch + Dinner | Stay: Sankri

### Day 06: Sankri – Dehradun Drive 193Km (7-8Hrs)

After an early breakfast depart for Dehradun. Upon arrival at Dehradun continue for your onward destination.
