Purpose

By signing this form, both campers and parents/guardians agree to uphold the expectations outlined below.

Behavioral Expectations

Campers are expected to:

1. Respect Others

- Be kind, courteous, and respectful toward fellow campers, staff, and volunteers at all times.
- Avoid using inappropriate language, teasing, bullying, or aggressive behavior.
- Listen to and follow instructions from camp staff.

2. Respect the Environment

- Take care of all camp materials, equipment, and facilities.
- Clean up after yourself and help keep the camp environment tidy and safe.

3. Participate Fully

- Engage actively in all camp activities and show a positive attitude.
- Be open to learning, trying new things, and collaborating with others.

4. Safety First

- Follow all safety rules and guidelines.
- Inform camp staff immediately if you notice something unsafe.
- Stay with your group at all times and do not leave the designated camp area without permission.

5. Be Responsible

- Take responsibility for your own actions and behavior.

- Be on time for activities and maintain a positive attitude.

Unacceptable Behaviors

The following behaviors will not be tolerated and may result in disciplinary actions or dismissal from camp:

- Physical violence or fighting.
- Bullying, harassment, or discrimination of any kind.
- Vandalism, theft, or damage to camp property or personal belongings.
- Possession of dangerous or prohibited items (weapons, drugs, etc.).
- Leaving campgrounds or activity areas without permission from staff.

Disciplinary Actions

Failure to adhere to the **Code of Conduct** may result in:

1. **Verbal Warning** – Staff will discuss the behavior and review camp expectations.
2. **Loss of Privileges** – Participation in certain activities may be restricted.
3. **Parent/Guardian Notification** – Parents/guardians will be informed of the situation and required to address the behavior.
4. **Dismissal from Camp** – If behavior does not improve or is of a serious nature, the camper may be dismissed from camp without refund.

Parent/Guardian Responsibilities

Parents/guardians are expected to:

- Support their camper in following this **Code of Conduct**.
- Review the camp rules with their camper and ensure they understand the consequences of inappropriate behavior.
- Respond promptly if contacted regarding any behavioral issues.
