#### **Updates with the Deans!**

- Cassandra Heifetz Dean, Lower School
  - Discussed parent teacher conferences via sign up genius or link to google calendar to select a time to sign up. Information is in the newsletter.
  - Application Cycle Closed Round One (November 3rd) vast majority of families completed the reenrollment application. Families are automatically enrolled for next year. Waitlist only applies to families not currently in the MVA. Families got an email around 5 PM confirming the application was complete.
  - MCPS has made the decision not to have a first grade option next year. MVA will be Grades 2-12 in 2024-2025.
  - Discussed School Improvement Plan Elementary Foundation, Middle Years and High School Years - topics include looking at literacy skills, math skills, college and career readiness, graduation.
