SUMMER LEAGUE RULES & SCHEDULE

CHECK-IN: Players who are registered need to check-in at the main gate to Malson Field at least 15 minutes prior to their scheduled game time. Players will receive their jersey, team assignment, and schedule. Once you receive your jersey, you need to bring it with you on a weekly basis.

FIELDS & FACILITIES: Games will be played at Scott Malson Field. The field is located at Hudson Middle School (77 Oviatt St., Hudson, Ohio 44236). We are guests of the Hudson City School District. Please pick up after your self and make sure all trash is put in waste cans around the fields.

PARKING: Parking should be done in the parking lots adjacent to the stadium.

WEATHER POLICY: The only time when games may be postponed or cancelled is due to lightening strikes in the area. If the game starts, it is considered a complete game. If there is a delay, we will take a 30-minute break in the action until the weather clears up. Players and spectators will be removed from the field and are asked to seek shelter in their cars. As soon as the weather permits play, a horn will be sounded and play will begin within 5-minutes.

RAIN DATE: In case of a cancellation, July 11 will serve as a rain date for cancelled games only.

TEAM ASSIGNMENTS: Team assignments will be made by the coaching staff prior to the first night. Some changes can or will be made for competitive balance of the league.

TRADING POLICY: Trades will be done on the field by the Field Director. Trades will only be made for the following reasons: 1. Carpool requests (extreme distances only). 2. Family members to be on the same team. 3. Players who are on a team by themselves and need to go to a team with other school members.

RULES OF PLAY: All players must have their team’s jersey
Players should report to their assigned field 10 minutes prior to game time
All protective equipment is required (goggles & mouthpiece included)
Two 24-minute running time halves with a 2-minute half-time
Players will respect the facility, coaches, and officials
