SUMMER LEAGUE RULES & SCHEDULE

CHECK-IN: Players who are registered need to check-in at East Woods Fields in Hudson at least 15-20 minutes prior to their session. Players will receive their jersey and team assignment. Once you receive your jersey, you need to bring it with you on a weekly basis.

FIELDS & FACILITIES: The game fields are located at East Woods School (120 N. Hayden Pkwy, Hudson, Ohio, 44236). We are guests of the Hudson City School District. Please pick up after your self and make sure all trash is put in waste cans around the fields. DO NOT PARK IN THE DAYCARE SPOTS NEAR THE SCHOOL DURING THE 5:00 PM TIME SLOT.

EQUIPMENT: Greater Cleveland Lacrosse doesn’t supply equipment for the league. Each player should have a helmet with mouthpiece, a stick, gloves, arm and shoulder pads, cleats for grass fields, their reversible jersey (supplied by the league), and a water bottle.

PARKING: There is to be NO parking in the fire lanes in front of East Woods. The swimming pool parking lot CANNOT be used until after 6:00 pm. Parking lots at McDowell Elementary, Evamere Elementary, Lavelli Stadium, and East Woods are all available. NO parking on the grass or on the street. Carpooling of players is highly suggested!

WEATHER POLICY: The only time when games may be postponed or cancelled is due to lightening strikes in the area. If the game starts, it is considered a complete game. If there is a delay, we will take a 30-minute break in the action until the weather clears up. Players and spectators will be removed from the field and are asked to seek shelter in their cars. As soon as the weather permits play, a horn will be sounded and play will begin within 5-minutes.

RAIN DATE: In case of a cancellation, July 11 will serve as a rain date for cancelled games only.

TEAM ASSIGNMENTS: Team assignments have been made prior to the start of the Summer League. Trades will be made on a limited basis. **Note:** No trades will be made after the first night!

TRADING POLICY: Trades will be done on the field by the Field Manager. 1. Carpool requests (extreme distances only). 2. Family members to be on the same team. 3. Players who are on a team by themselves and need to go to a team with other school members. All protective equipment is required (mouthpiece included)

- Teams need 8-10 players to compete in the game (forfeit if under 8)
- MS and HS Division games will play by NFHS rules (penalties will result in a 4 v. 3 fast break)
- Elite Division games will play by NCAA rules (penalties will be time served)
- Two 24-minute running time halves with a 2-minute half-time (OT is sudden victory)
- Players will respect the facility, coaches, and officials (clean up after yourself)
- Fighting or inappropriate language will result in expulsion from the league
