When this permit is approved, the property owner listed above will be allowed to begin and complete the work listed below and agrees to clean-up of all debris within ninety (90) days of the approved date of this permit. The property owner is liable for any and all damages to POA property, including roads, caused by the contracted work. If your lot is not cleaned up after 90 days, a fine of \$250.00 will be imposed. If the fine is not paid within 30 days of issued, further legal action will be taken.

Before cutting of trees on SRA leaseback on Waterfront Lots, SRA must be called 409-565-2273. The property owner must call **811** to verify clearance of electrical lines and call your local water distribution company to verify where the water lines are, and they are to be marked. If there is any damage to those lines, the property owner or person causing the damage is liable for the damages and will be charged accordingly.

Trees to be cut are to be marked before approval of permit will be given. Pictures will be taken before and after by the permit chairperson. **If any trees are cut without prior approval, the property owner will be imposed with a fine of \$500.00.** If the fine is not paid within 30 days of issued, further legal action will be taken.

This permit expires 90 days from the approval date. If the property owner needs an extension, they must re-submit a new permit before the expiration date.
