North Carolina Bowling All Stars Code of Ethics (Bowlers & Parents)

- Your attendance at all events and practices is imperative. All practices are strongly encouraged any. Membership fee will be \$150 for returning bowlers and \$180 for new members. If you are chosen to be team member and are not able to attend, please contact Angel Metsch or your teams coach ASAP so alternatives can be contacted.
- You are expected to be respectful to teammates, always opposing teams and coaches.
- Foul language and obscene hand gestures will not be tolerated.
- You are not only representing yourself but also the State of North Carolina. You are expected to be on your best behavior on the lanes and off the lanes.
- You are expected to stay on your lanes during competition. Do not leave your lanes unless it is ok'd by your coach.
- Electronics must be with parents or put away in bags. Electronics are not allowed in the settee area. You will be asked to put it away once. Second offense and we will ask a parent to obtain the device.
- There should be a 12AM curfew on Friday & Saturday nights of competition. We ask that
 parents enforce this so you will be ready to bowl each morning. You are expected to be on your
 best behavior during your stay at the hotel as well.
- Dress code for competition will be State Jersey and black dress pants. Female bowlers are allowed to wear a black skort. Skorts must be at least fingertip length. If your skort is questionable, you will be asked to change. If you're not sure, change, or pack a backup.
- Proper bowling attire should be worn to practice. (No short shorts or tank tops)
- Should you not wish to be photographed please let us know.
- Parents are required to stay outside of the bowling circle unless advised by a coach or director.
- Parents should remain respectful to all bowlers, competitors, coaching and staff. You represent us just as much as the bowlers do.
- Parents should report any issues they may have to the NC Director immediately.
- Any child subject to breaking any of the above rules will be issued a warning. If the violation should continue the bowler will be asked to leave and further membership and participation will be discussed depending on the violation.
- Any Parent violating this policy, disrespecting bowlers (including their own) or coaches, or showing any questionable mannerisms will be warned. If it shall happen again the parent will be asked to leave the facility and wait for their bowler outside.
