



## KNOW THE TOWN CODE

- **Sec. 11-1-40. - Repair and maintenance.**

The owner, occupant, lessee or person in possession or control of any premises or property shall maintain the sidewalks adjoining such premises or property in good repair and in a safe, unobstructed condition, free of **snow**, weeds, and debris.

- **Sec. 11-1-50. - **Snow** and ice removal from sidewalks.**

The owner, occupant, lessee, or person in possession or control of any premises or property shall maintain the sidewalks adjoining such premises or property and shall remove and clear away, or cause to be removed or cleared away, **snow** and ice from sidewalks in all business districts within the Town within four business hours after the cessation of any fall of **snow**, sleet or freezing rain or by the beginning hours of the next business day following such fall, whichever period is shorter, and from all other sidewalks in the Town within 24 hours of the cessation of any fall of **snow**, sleet or freezing rain.
