

REASONS SET FORTH IN THE PETITION TO RECALL TRUSTEE JON BERNHARDT

As electors of the city of Pierce, we demand a recall election. Jon Bernhardt voted no on all issues regarding the annexation of the Rimrock plant, in total disregard of the desires of over 300 electors in the town of Pierce, demanding that he vote yes on the issues; and did not share a reason for disregarding what the people of the Town of Pierce wanted. He has shown an unprofessional and discourteous attitude when conversing with electors speaking during town board meetings.
