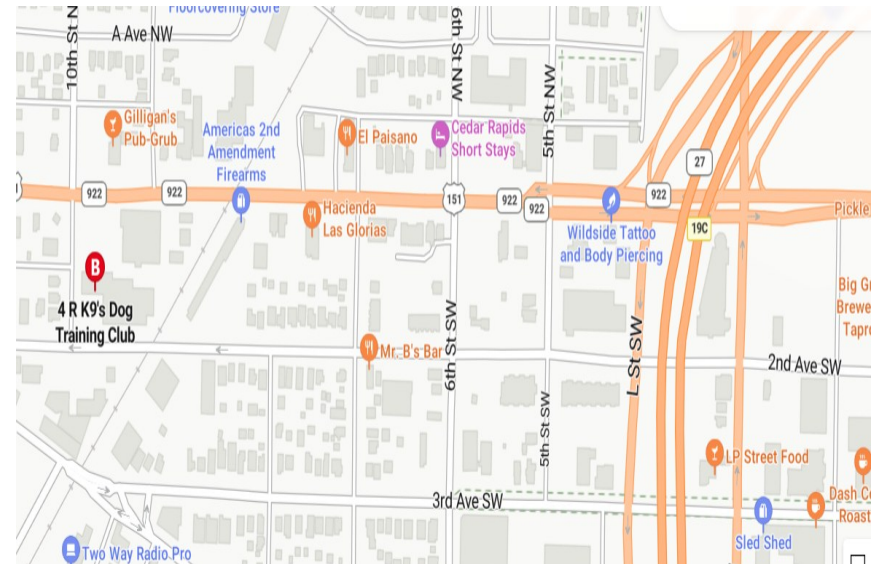
From I-380 North

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

BITCHES IN SEASON (on the date of the show) are not permitted to compete. Refunds less \$5 administrative fee per class entered per day will be made for bitches that come in season after the closing date for the trial. Written Notification to claim refund must be received by the Secretary by Saturday, June 20, 2026.

NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. Every effort will be made to find duplicate entries; however, if the entry has been processed, no refund will be made. Refunds of \$3.00 & less will not be issued due to the costs of processing.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON LEASH OR CONFINED TO THEIR CRATES except when being judged.

ALL VIDEOTAPING during the Show requires Club permission.

Any exhibitor arguing with show officials or exhibiting unsportsmanlike behavior will be subject to Event Committee Jurisdiction.

Please note: Limited crating space may be available in the main room of the building. **4RK9s requests that all exhibitors bring a mat to place under their dog(s) crate(s) and their chair. This is to make clean up easier at the end of the trials. If you spill food/water/or anything, clean up materials are available for you to keep your crating area clean. All crates in this area must be placed on top of crate mats.** ICDOC reserves the right to ask any exhibitor whose dog is creating a disturbance, or whose crate may potentially damage the flooring to move his/her crate(s) to the back room.

ATTENTION: JUMP HEIGHT REQUIRED ON ENTRY FORM!

Per Chapter 1, Section 3 of the AKC Obedience Regulations amended June 2008 and effective January 1, 2015, entries must include a jump height to be acceptable.

OBEDIENCE entries in the classes that use jumps (Open, Utility, Graduate Novice, Graduate Open, Versatility) must include a jump height on the entry form in order to be a valid entry. Entries WILL be arranged by jump height (tall to small) at these trials.

The minimum jump height for breeds listed in Appendix A of the AKC Obedience Regulations shall be set to three-quarters the dog's height at the withers. This jump height shall also be rounded to a multiple of 2 inches.
