I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Conditional, unsigned or incomplete entries or entries received without fees will not be accepted. Telephone or email entries are not acceptable. All cancellations must be written and received by the Show Secretary before the closing of entries.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e. Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

RIBBON AND ROSETTE PRIZES

Iowa City Dog Obedience Club offers the following ribbons and rosettes for each Rally trial:

HIGHEST COMBINED SCORING DOG IN ADVANCED B & EXCELLENT B CLASSES

Blue & Green Rosette

HIGHEST TRIPLE SCORE (ADVANCED B, EXCELLENT B & MASTERS)

Blue & Red Rosette

A dark green ribbon will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score.

First Place.....Blue Ribbon

Second Place.....Red Ribbon

Third Place.....Yellow Ribbon

Fourth Place.....White Ribbon

A special rosette will be awarded to each team completing their RACH Title. Rosettes will be offered for each dog completing an Rally title at these trials.

Please note: Limited crating space may be available in the main room of the building. **4RK9s requests that all exhibitors bring a mat to place under their dog(s) crate(s) and their chair. This is to make clean up easier at the end of the trials. If you spill food/water/or anything, clean up materials are available for you to keep your crating area clean. All crates in this area must be placed on top of crate mats. ICDOC reserves the right to ask any exhibitor whose dog is creating a disturbance, or whose crate may potentially damage the flooring to move his/her crate(s) to the back room.**

No entry fees will be refunded if the trials cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. ICDOC reserves the right to cancel these trials in the event of extreme weather conditions and no entry fee refunds will be made in such case.

Bitches in season are not permitted in the Trial. Exhibitors may request a refund of entries, minus a \$10 per entry processing fee, for bitches that come into season after the closing date, as long as the trial secretary is provided documentation from a veterinarian at least 30 minutes prior to the beginning of the day's judging.

Iowa City Dog Obedience Club policy allows the Rally Chairman & Rally trial secretary to enter these events.

Refunds will not be given for overpayments of \$10 or less.

CATALOGS

Catalogs may be ordered with your entries for \$3.00 per copy. They may be picked up the day of the trial. A limited number of catalogs will be available to purchase at the trial for \$5.00 per copy.

ROUTES TO THE SHOW SITE:

From I-380 South

Exit 5th Ave SW, continue on 3rd St SW to 2nd Ave SW. Turn left onto 2nd Ave SW (one way) and stay in the right lane. Continue to 10th St SW, then turn right onto 10th St SW.

From I-380 North

Exit 1st Ave W. Turn right onto 1st Ave SW and get in the left lane. Continue to 10th St and turn left onto 10th St SW.

All owners/exhibitors should be aware that ICDOC considers the entire motel and grounds to be within the trial limits. You will be responsible for all damage to your room and may be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the rules of the AKC. Any abuse of the motel/adjoining grounds will be brought to the attention of the Trial Committee. Any exhibitor's entries may be refused for previous misuse of the motel facilities. This is an AKC supported measure.

FOOD

NO Food will be available for purchase on-site during these trials.

There are fast food restaurants nearby.

Attention Exhibitors

SHOW SITE WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR SET UP AT 7 AM Saturday & Sunday .. The building will be closed and dogs must be removed from the show site each trial day within 30 minutes following the conclusion of all trial activities.

Ring size will be according to AKC Regulations.

Please leave the motel and motel grounds clean. Any complaints from proprietors will be handled by the Show Committee.

Telephone, email and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an Official AKC Entry Form and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

Make all checks and money orders payable to Iowa City Dog Obedience Club. Canadian exhibitors must make fees payable in US funds. Payment must accompany entries.

Mail all entries to Deb Owens, 508 2nd Ave, Luther, IA 50152. Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practical. Unless an exhibitor specifically requests postal communication, submission of an email address on the entry form will serve as authorization to send communication, including entry confirmation via email. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that their email software will accept messages from ICDOCobsecretary@gmail.com

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee or AKC. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance, and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

ICDOC does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for these events.

Owners are responsible for errors on completed entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Post-dated and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. A collection fee will be added to the amount of each returned check.

No refund for duplicate entries. Care will be taken to find duplicates, however, if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the trial site. There will be no refunds of entry fees if a person is asked to leave the trial site.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled judging. Dogs not required for further judging may be excused. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

Class prizes will be distributed in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims must be made in the ring before the judging for that show is over, and the Secretary advised at once. All prizes must be claimed at the show. If not, they become the property of ICDOC. No prizes will be mailed.

ICDOC, the show secretary, members of the show committee, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by spectators, exhibitors, handlers, their employees or children, etc. or to any of their dogs or property. Entrants and spectators to this show do so entirely at their own risk.

This show is governed by The American Kennel Club. Exhibitors should read the AKC agreement on the entry blank in the premium list.

\$1.00 per exhibitor applied for admission. One admission per dog entered. General admission fee for nonparticipants is \$1.00 per day.
