All order forms must be turned in by **Friday, May 8th, 2026, End of school day or close of Business**, there will be no exceptions to this rule. No late orders. Completed order forms need to be turned into your FFA Advisor or Austin County 4H Office.

We, the undersigned, have read the Austin County Fair Livestock Catalog and agree to abide by all rules and regulations pertaining to the animal listed on this validation and order form. We also agree that if for some reason the animal listed above will be out of our care or fed at another location than listed above for a period of 72 hours or more, we will inform the broiler committee chairman.
