2025 ACF Cutting Contest Rules

- 1. Individuals must be entered in the Austin County Fair Ag Mechanics Show in order to participate.
- 2. The contest will take place during the ACF Ag Mech Show.
- 3. Participants must check in by 1:00pm on October 6, 2025.
- 4. Entry fee of \$25 due at check-in. Checks only
- 5. Participants must provide their own PPE, which must include:
 - a. Long sleeve natural fiber shirt
 - b. Long pants/jeans
 - c. Closed toe leather shoes/boots (improper footwear will not be allowed)
 - d. Z87 approved eyewear
 - e. Shade 5 face shield or safety glasses
- 6. Shade 5 face shields and gloves will be available for use.
- 7. Format will be as follows:
 - a. Round 1: Top 16 times will advance
 - b. Rounds 2 5: Head to head elimination
- 8. Participants will be allowed to check torch valves prior to starting, but must lay the torch and striker on the table before beginning the round.
- 9. If judges determine that a tip is dirty, both tips will be cleaned by contest officials prior to the next round. Equipment malfunctions that cause an unfair advantage to one contestant may result in a "re-ride" if judges deem it appropriate.
- 10. Immediate disqualification from contest:
 - a. Torch not lit within 15 seconds
 - b. Knocking, tapping, hitting, etc. to assist cut part to fall
 - c. Any unsafe cutting practices
- 11. Contestants may choose the torch/table they use to cut on. If both students choose the same station, a coin flip will determine student placement.
- 12. Final rulings will be made by the Lead Contest Judge
- 13. Awards: Will be available at time of fair check disbursement
 - a. Grand Champion 50% entry pot
 - b. Reserve Grand Champion 30% entry pot
