Container Plants Competition Judging Criteria

These will be the guidelines the judges will use to score each individual design. 100 points are possible.

Design 40 points total (4 elements @ 10 pts each)

- Plant groupings and types suitable with the container/theme
- Plant number and size appropriate for container
- Entry designed to be viewed from all sides
- · Plants have been grown in container and securely rooted

Plants & Quality 30 points total (5 elements @ 6 pts each)

- Features at least 3 different species of plants
- Display attracts attention, holds viewer's interest, and is sale worth in auction
- Plants chosen work together in related elements (water, sun, temp, etc.)
- Plants enhance the theme chosen
- Plants are healthy with no signs of pests or disease

Staging & Display 20 points total (5 elements @ 4 pts each)

- Container, additional media, or design elements enhances creative presentation of entry
- Display shows imagination, creative thought, originality
- Double potting is acceptable with suitable media and/or top dressing used in all pots
- Terrarium NOT double potted
- Plants in natural form without leaf or foliage enhancers used

Project Log 10 points total (5 elements @ 2 pts each)

- Official ACF log used (found on ACF Horticulture site to download)
- Narrative describing entry inspiration and creative process
- 10 + printed photos over 8-week student owned & grown project
- Plants used listed with genus, species, common name, cultivar, variety
- Timeline of planting/maintenance and cost of project included
