2020 Bucket Calf Show

Rules and Information Sheet



We are excited that you have chosen to participate in the 2020 Austin County Fair and Livestock Show Bucket Calf Show. The project was started to expose youth to the basic care and responsibility of caring for a calf.

Guidelines

Eligibility

- Open to Austin County youth ages 4 - 8 years old, Pre-Kindergarten to 2nd grade. Participants turning 9 as of August 31, 2020 are ineligible.
- Participant must attend 3 Bucket Calf Project meetings between February and September.
- Meetings are held the 3rd Monday of every month at the Bellville Volunteer Fire Station from 6:30 – 7:30 pm.
- Participant must be able to halter break and lead a calf.
- Participant **must attend** the mandatory Progress Show on Saturday, August 15, 2020 in order to show at the Austin County Fair. *(The Progress Show attendance does not count towards the 3 meetings.)*

Calf Requirements

- Project calf must be born between May 1, 2020 and July 8, 2020 (must be born 6 weeks prior to Progress Show).
- All bucket calves are required to be vaccinated by **August 1, 2020** of current year.
- Calf must be bottle fed. No nurse calves.
- Project calves can be any gender/breed.
- If a calf becomes ill and/or dies, a replacement calf can be purchased as long as it is born before July 8, 2020.

Project Requirements

- Entry Form completed and fee of \$40 due at Progress Show.
- Participant is required to keep a record log and it must be presented and signed by a Bucket Calf Committeeman prior to the Austin County Fair Bucket Calf Show.
- Read and be familiar with the general rules stated in the Rules and Regulations of the Austin County Fair & Livestock Association, including the NO PASS- NO PLAY policies and the Substance Avoidance Program.
