Youth Supreme & Country Auction



Rules for Youth Supreme & Country Auction

- Youth Exhibitors can participate in both the Youth Auction Sale with animal and Youth Supreme & Country Auction
- Exhibitors earning Supreme Champion will have the Option to sell in the Youth Supreme & Country Auction
- Exhibitors will receive the money minus any Reserve and the 7% Admin fee (Miniscapes & Fair Cup)
- If Exhibitor makes Supreme in multiple categories, Exhibitor must declare which item they want to sell – Only allowed to sell one (1) item
- Items will not move up if an Exhibitor has multiple Supreme items
- Exhibitors have the option to OPT OUT of the Youth Supreme Sale

Rules Continued

- Exhibitor must be present to sell their item
- Possible 30 lots to sell as Supreme from all categories
- **Full set of Rules are located in the Home Economics Catalog with Exception of Ag Mechanics is listed in the Premium Book**
- Same No Pass No Play Applies the same as the YAS
- Same YAS rules apply to the YS & CA
 - Can't ask Buyer for your entry back
- Thank you notes will be required
- Checks will be ready for pick up at the same time as YAS checks
- For teams of two Split checks will be issued
- Addons can be added to Youth Supreme Items

Rules Continued

- Youth Supreme Items will be on display in the designated area (Country Auction)
- Items too large to be included will have a picture on display
 - Videos & Pictures will be used on the screen during the sale

- Ag Mechanics (2 Lots) – October 2
- Fair Cup (4 Lots) – Space still Available!
- Horticulture
 - Container Plants (4 Lots) – August 7
 - Miniscapes (4 Lots) - Full
- Home Economics- Oct 9 (4 to 6:45pm)/Oct 10 (9:30 to 11:30 am)
 - All Categories (14 Lots)
- Art (2 Lots) – Same as Home Economics

Ag Mechanics

- Only Austin County Ag Mechanics Projects can be considered for Youth Supreme & Country Auction
- Grand Champion & Reserve Champion will advance to the Youth Supreme level
- Projects funded only by individuals will be considered (School funded projects Not Allowed)
- Team projects funded individually are acceptable
- If projects are too large to be displayed inside the Expo, pictures and videos will be on display
- Videos will be shown during the sale
- Deadline for Entries: Monday, October 2 at 5:00 p.m.
- Mail Entries to: Austin County Fair, Attn: Ag Mechanics Entry P.O. Box 141, Bellville, TX 77418
- Entry Fee: \$25 per Project
- Project Check In: Monday, October 9 from 3:00 – 4:00 p.m. Judging begins at 4:00 p.m.

Floral Design – Fair Cup Contest

- Floral Design will not be included
- Fair Cup Grand & Reserve Champion in Juniors & Seniors will make a silk piece for the Auction
- Fair Cup Lots
 - Junior (40 Max)
 - Supreme Grand Champion
 - Supreme Reserve Champion
 - Senior (40 Max)
 - Supreme Grand Champion
 - Supreme Reserve Champion
- Exhibitors will receive the selling amount Minus the Reserve to cover the cost of silk supplies and the 7% Admin Fee
- Entries close when full or September 1st

Horticulture – Container Plants & Miniscapes

- Both Miniscapes and Container Plants will be included
- Grand & Reserve Champion Container Plants (No Limit this year)
 - Juniors
 - Seniors
- Grand & Reserve Champion Miniscapes – (24 Max)
 - Juniors
 - Seniors

Home Economics

- Home Economic Categories for Youth Supreme
- The Supreme Champions from each Division below will advance to the Youth Supreme Auction
 - Clothing & Needlework (2)
 - Home Improvement (2)
 - Flower Show (2)
 - Baked Goods (2)
 - Canned Foods (2)
 - Photography (2)
 - Quilts (2)

Home Economics Cont.

- There are three groups of Youth Home Economics
 - 4-H/FFA Junior (3rd to 8th Grade)
 - 4-H/FFA/FCCLA Senior (9th to 12th Grade)
 - Open (Non 4H members/Home School/GT)
- Grand & Reserve Champions will be chosen based on judging criteria in each Division
- Grand & Reserve Champions will be judged again by a different set of Judges responsible for choosing Youth Supreme
- Items not advancing to the Supreme Level can be donated to the Country Auction however the funds will go towards the Country Auction, not the exhibitor.

Art

- Art has two Divisions
 - School Art (Completed with Teacher/At School)
 - Elementary
 - Junior High
 - High School
 - Open Youth (Completed without Instruction/At Home)
- Entries receiving Best of Show & Honorable Mention will be evaluated for Overall Grand & Reserve Champion
- Two (2) pieces will be chosen for Supreme Grand and Supreme Reserve Champion Art
