## **Marshall County Airport Board Minutes**

## Thursday June 13, 2024

### 1. Call To Order and Roll Call

President McKee called the rescheduled meeting to order at 6:32 PM. Roll call was taken and members present were: Mr. Flahaven, Mr. Sloan, Mr. Flanigan, Mr. Kenyon, and President McKee. Also in attendance were Mr. Gauwitz, County Board Chairman, Mr. Carboni from GreenWing Aviation and the Airport Manager, Mr. Troglio.

# 2. Minutes of Last Meeting

The minutes from the May 9, 2024, meeting were distributed to and reviewed by the members. Mr. Kenyon motioned to approve the minutes; Mr. Flanigan seconded the motion. The motion carried.

### 3. Public Input

Mr. Gauwitz was asked by the County Clerk to provide to her a PTO package for the airport manager and his employee due to the recent Paid Leave for All Workers Act, effective 1-1-24. Under the Act, employees can earn at least 1 hour of paid time off for every 40 hours worked, up to 40 hours in a 12-month period. President McKee directed Mr. Troglio to provide an appropriate PTO package to the Clerk for MCA Airport employees.

# 4. Financial Report

The MCA Financial Report was presented by Mr. Troglio for May 2024. The Board had a short discussion on the CD rates of the local banks. Mr. Flanigan motioned to approve the financial report as presented; Mr. Flahaven seconded the motion. The motion carried.

- **EAA Father's Day Breakfast:** Planning for the event is on-going. The setup will take place on Saturday, June 15, 2024. The event starts at 7am on the 16<sup>th</sup>. A safety seminar is also scheduled for June 17<sup>th</sup> at 6pm in the MCA Lobby.
