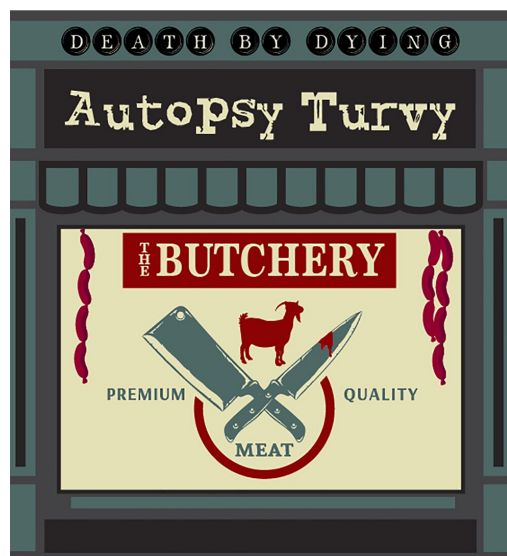
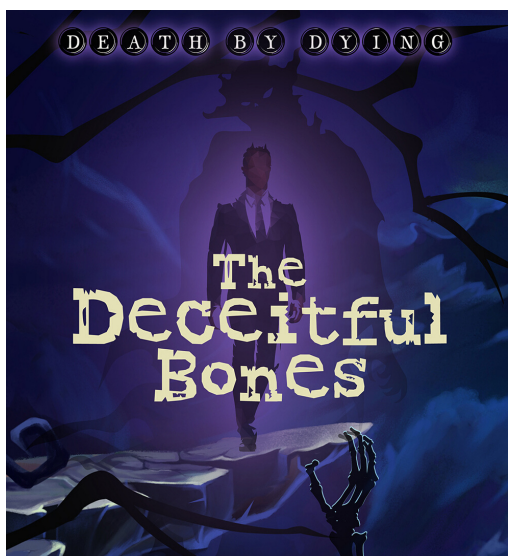
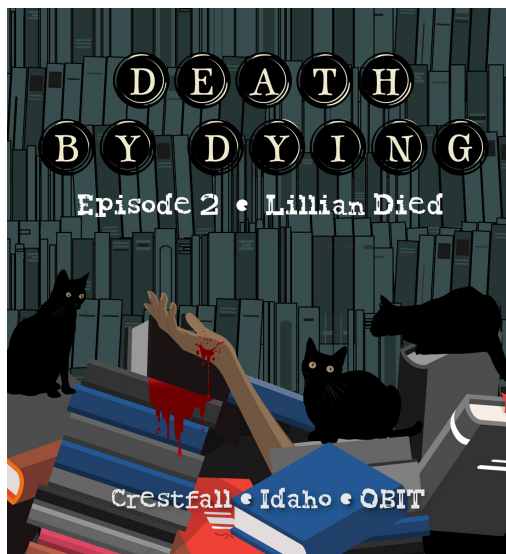

ABOUT THE SHOW



Death by Dying is a dark comedy fiction podcast that serves as the obituary column for the charming town of Crestfall, Idaho. The Obituary Writer finds himself deeply in over his head as he investigates a series of strange and mysterious deaths... when he is supposed to simply be writing obituaries. On his strange misadventures, he comes across a nameless man trapped in an abandoned silo, a hidden library of the town's secrets, a pair of twin vampiric nuns, a league of haunted bicycles, and an ominous beast stalking the Dark Woods. The deaths start becoming more personal when the Obituary Writer makes his first and only friend, Charlotte Dawson, whose aunt passed away due to a surprisingly deep paper cut and a fatal blood disease. The two begin to uncover the sinister secrets of the Dark Woods...

The goal of the class was simple: assemble one episode of a podcast over the course of the semester. The only problem was... all of the assignments were geared towards nonfiction! And Evan's heart very much belongs to fiction! Evan's teacher was successfully won over to the sweet, sweet dark side of fiction, and contacted Niko Gerentes, The Man of a Thousand Voices and president of Columbia's audio drama club. Niko became fascinated by the strange yet heartfelt story Evan was developing and through his technological know-how helped make a full season. And the rest, as they say, was *Death by Dying*.

THE LIVE FUNERAL

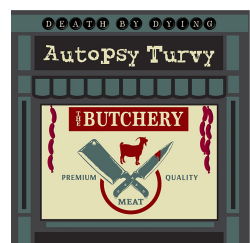
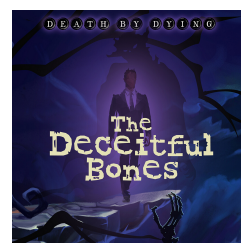

The *Death by Dying* crew was invited to participate in the Chicago Podcast Festival in December of 2018. During the live show, the audience attended the funeral of Crestfall's very own Samuel Plunk, a secret handyman who died after a suspicious repair job accident. With a mystery to solve, heartfelt eulogies that had nothing to do with the deceased, and a grand finale musical performance of "Johnny Left His Bootstraps in the Promised Land" by The Bally-Go-Backward Boys, a funeral has certainly never felt so lively.

TALES FROM CRESTFALL

In Fall 2019, *Death by Dying* released the premiere episode of *Tales from Crestfall*, a three-part bonus miniseries during its off-season. Each episode is a standalone story expanding upon the world of Crestfall, Idaho. From outlandish folktales told by the Obituary Writer to the misadventures of Crestfall's resident Butcher, *Tales from Crestfall* is the perfect taste of *Death by Dying* for both people who are new to the show and fans of Season 1.

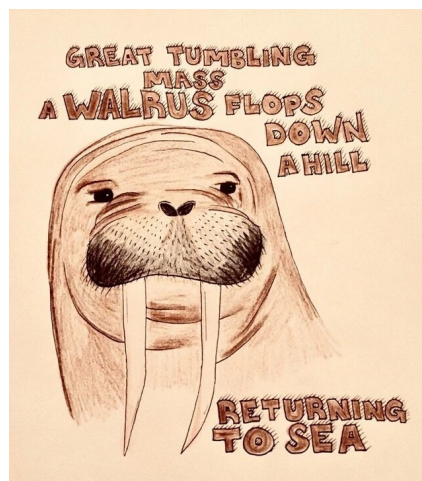
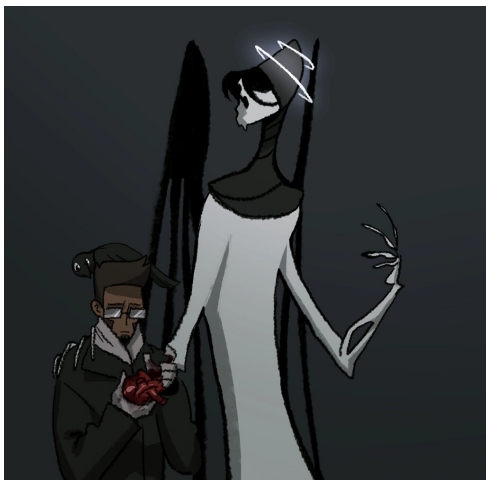
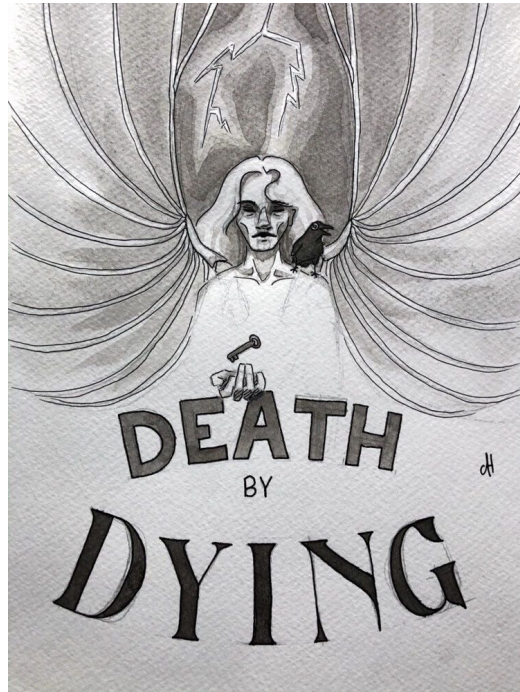
