You may have received a 2022 notice/door hanger regarding property maintenance, per our HOA Covenants. If you are a tenant, you and the property owner will recive a notice. We expect full cooperation as it takes all of us to make the comumnity a great place to live in.

Current Concerns From your Neighbors:

- Loud music after hours
- ➤ Undrivable vehicles- any vehicle not in a driving condition must be concealed from public view.
- > Dod owners not cleaning up after their dod
- ➤ Garbage/Recicle bins being on the curb on non-pick up days

Any household doing these activities are in violation of the HOA Covenants. Don't do it.
