Day by Day Itinerary

Monday, June 23 - Depart for Ashland, Wisconsin

We depart early this morning for our first day of travel. After a stop for lunch on our own along the way, we'll end our day's journey in the city of Ashland, a port on the southern shore of Lake Superior, near the head of Chequamegon Bay. We will enjoy a prime rib dinner in town at the Deep Water Grille, housed within a building dating back to 1889. After dinner we check into the beautiful, historic Hotel Chequamegon in Ashland. (D)

Tuesday, June 24 - Ashland / Bayfield / Apostle Islands National Lakeshore
Following Breakfast at our hotel, we will begin the day by traveling a bit further
north to the city of Bayfield, a former county seat, lumbering town, and
commercial fishing community, and today a tourist and resort destination. Bayfield
is the gateway to the Apostle Islands National Lakeshore, and today we'll depart for
a boat cruise through the islands, a 2-1/2 hour morning tour, where we can view
sea caves and lighthouses. Upon arrival back in Bayfield at noon, we'll have lunch
on our own and time for shopping in town. In the afternoon, we'll stop at the
Apostle Islands National Lakeshore Museum to see a video and view the exhibits.





Now it is time to enjoy wine tasting at Bayfield Winery & Blue Ox Cider. This family owned and operated winery and cidery welcomes you to their beautiful little piece of earth. Phil will explain the history of his property and says, relax, slow down and enjoy your choice of his wine and cider! Wisconsin cheese will be served. Tonight, we'll have a farm to table dinner at Harbor Table Restaurant, overlooking Lake Superior. (B,D)

<u>Wednesday, June 25</u> - Ashland / Madeline Island Today we'll have breakfast at the hotel, then

leave once again for Bayfield, where we'll take a shore ferry ride to enjoy the day on Madeline Island, the only one of the Apostle Islands that's inhabited. Upon disembarking the ferry in the town of LaPointe, we'll be met by a local guide who will give us a narrated tour of the various points of interest on the island, including Big Bay State Park, for a beautiful view of Lake Superior. We'll stop at Madeline Island Museum, owned and operated by the Wisconsin Historical Society, where we'll see a video, have a narrated tour, and time in the gift shop.



After seeing more of the island, we'll have lunch on our own, then go to specialty shops, such as Woods Hall Gallery and Studios, an island cooperative, for handcrafts, books and souvenirs created by local weavers and artists, some of whom work on-site in the studio.

After the ferry returns us to Bayfield in the later afternoon, we will head back to the hotel for a little R&R before we have dinner at The Landings Restaurant in our hotel. After dinner, there is an optional transfer to the Legendary Waters

Casino to try your luck in the casino. (B,D)

Thursday, June 26 - Ashland / Bayfield / Hauser Farms / Erickson Orchards
After breakfast at the hotel, we'll board the coach and tour the Historic Murals of
Ashland, located mostly in the 8-block Main Street business district, which is listed
on the National Register of Historic Places. We'll then continue to the Northern
Great Lakes Visitor Center, where we can view video and exhibits, go up to the
observation tower, and spend time in the gift shop. Afterward, we'll board the



coach and return to Bayfield, where we'll stop in town for lunch on our own and shopping. Then take a guided city tour of Bayfield, with an informative description of the various historic locations in and around town.



Then it's on to Hauser Farms, followed by shopping at Erickson Orchard. Some favorite items to bring home include apple wine, apple syrup, and various jams, butters, and spreads. After our farm and orchard visits, our tour will end at the Old Rittenhouse Inn, built in 1890 in the Queen Anne style. Enjoy a short presentation about the Rittenhouse and then we'll settle in and enjoy an elegant three-course Victorian Dinner at the Landmark Restaurant in this lovely, historic inn. (B,D)

Friday, June 27 - Leave Ashland, depart for home

After Breakfast at the hotel, it'll be time to depart for home with happy memories of the Apostle Islands. (B)
