Here, we find the Se Cathedral, San Jorge Castle and more. This evening, we enjoy Fado music and dance performance and dinner as a group. B, D

### DAY 4: Friday, Aug. 1, 2025 • Fatima -

This morning, we depart by coach to Porto where we board our cruise. Enroute, we stop in Fatima where apparitions of the Virgin Mary appeared in 1917. We hear the story of Our Lady of the Rosary that appeared to three shepherd children in the nearby fields and have some time to explore and for lunch on our own. Time permitting, we stop in Coimbra where we have free time to explore and shop and perhaps

### **DOURO RIVER CRUISE**

#### DAY 5: Saturday, Aug. 2, 2025 • Régua

This tranquil village offers an authentic slice of Douro River life. Indulge in a traditional Portuguese lunch with your fellow travelers in Regua at a local quinta – a country estate – for a truly authentic culinary experience. ### DAY 6: Sunday, Aug. 3, 2025 • Vega de Terrón

white and blue tiles, which the more active adventurer will want to climb on a guided hike. Concluding both tours, you will have the opportunity to sample local traditional specialties, such as bôlas de Lamego, bread filled with smoked ham; presunto, a type of dry-cured ham; and Espumante, a Portuguese sparkling wine. ### DAY 10: Thursday, Aug. 7, 2025 • Porto

The colorful city of Porto blends the best of old and new, which you can discover on an escorted tour of the historic quarter, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, including the Cathedral, one of the city's oldest monuments; and the São Bento Railway Station, known for its blue and white tile panels depicting scenes from Portuguese history. If you prefer to get more active, you can go on a guided hike. In the afternoon, you'll also enjoy a tasting of Port, Portugal's renowned contribution to the world of wine. In the evening, relax on board during scenic cruise to Afurada, a magical fishing village, where you can explore during your free time. (B,L,D)
