SNOW EMERGENCY PROCLAMTION

The Borough of St. Lawrence has determined that conditions may occur, based on a Winter Storm Watch issued by the U.S. National Weather Service Mt Holly Office for additional heavy snow, which will require the restriction of traffic and parking for public health and safety. The Borough hereby will declare a Snow Emergency, per St. Lawrence Borough Ordinance #426 adopted October 9, 2014.

The Snow Emergency will begin at **7:00 PM on Saturday January 24, 2026** and will end at **12 PM on Tuesday January 27, 2026** - CONDITIONS PERMITTING.

VEHICLES MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE SNOW EMERGENCY ROUTES. VEHICLES NOT REMOVED FROM SNOW EMERGENCY ROUTES MAY BE CITED AND TOWED AT THE OWNER'S EXPENSE.

The following streets will be under this snow emergency order:

St Lawrence Ave - Entire Length of the Borough on Both Sides
Oley Turnpike Rd - Entire Length of the Borough on Both Sides
Adams Street: Both Sides for its Entire Length
Jacksonwald Ave: From Chestnut St to Ganster St - Even Number (South) Side
Jacksonwald Ave: Around The Mall
Ganster St: Both Sides
Stoner Ave: From Adams St To Chestnut St: Odd Number (North) Side
Elm St: Even Number (West) Side for its Entire Length
Patton St: Walnut St to Brown St Both Sides
Patton St: Brown St to Elm St: Even Number (South) Side
Lynn Ct: Entire Length Both Sides and Circle
Orchard Ct: Entire Length Both Sides and Circle
Penn's Ct: Entire Length Both Sides and Circle
Poplar Dr: Intersection of Teak Dr to the cul-de-sac - Both Sides and Circle
