ORDINANCE NO. 449

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF ST. LAWRENCE, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, LEVYING THE REAL ESTATE PROPERTY TAX AND FIXING THE RATE THEREOF FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2022.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of St. Lawrence, Berks County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION I. A tax is hereby levied on all real estate property within the Borough of St. Lawrence, subject to taxation for Borough purposes for the fiscal year 2022, commencing January 1, 2022, as follows:

The tax rate for general Borough purposes shall be in the sum of 7.00 mills (.0070) on each dollar of assessed valuation and a fire tax at a sum of .68 mills (.00068) on each dollar of assessed valuation.

<u>SECTION II.</u> Any ordinance or part of any ordinance inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.
