Hunter understands that this release discharges the Borough from any liability or claim that the Hunter may have against the Borough with respect to any bodily injury, personal injury, illness, death, or property damage that may result from Hunter's activities with the Borough, whether caused by the negligence of the Borough or its officers, directors, employees, agents or otherwise. Hunter also understands that the Borough does not assume any responsibility for or obligation to provide financial assistance or other assistance, including, but not limited to, medical, health, or disability insurance in the event of injury or illness.

Hunter understands that, except as otherwise agreed to by the Borough in writing, the Borough does not carry or maintain health, medical, or disability insurance coverage for any Hunter. Each Hunter is expected and encouraged to obtain his or her own medical or health insurance coverage.

Hunter expressly agrees that this Release is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and that this Release shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Hunter agrees that in the event that any clause or provision of this Release shall be held to be invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity of such clause

or provision shall not otherwise affect the remaining provisions of this Release which shall continue to be enforceable.

In consideration of the Borough allowing me to enter this Borough property for the limited purposes set forth herein, I hereby forever WAIVE, RELEASE, DISCHARGE, INDEMNIFY, AND HOLD HARMLESS the Borough, its officials, agents, employees, contractors, and professional consultants, and the successors and assigns of the same from any and all liability, including claims or causes of action of any nature, suits at law or in equity, which may arise from participation in the activity described above. I understand that this includes, but is not limited to, claims for personal injury, death, or property damage which may arise now or in the future as a result of participation in the above-described activities and/or my entry onto the property. I agree not to sue the Borough, its officials, agents, employees, contractors, and professional consultants, and the successors and assigns of the same for any injury related to the activities described herein. I further agree to indemnify the Borough in the event of any claim against it based upon this permission. I understand that this agreement is binding on me, and on my heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns. I further understand that this permission is revocable by the Borough at its discretion, at any time, and for any reason.

In addition to abiding by the Pennsylvania Game Laws. I will obey all Rules and Regulations according to Ordinance 453-2023 of the Borough of St. Lawrence, Berks County Pennsylvania. I also understand that failure to comply with all regulations will result in the revocation of this permit and may subject me to prosecution under law.

GENERAL HUNTING REGULATIONS

1. Borough Permit must be carried and visible at all times in the same manner as PA Hunting License.
2. Pennsylvania hunting laws and regulations, and all applicable regulations on use of public lands, are to be obeyed at all times. Hunters must follow all rules and regulations in the **Borough of St. Lawrence Ordinance NO 453-2023**.
3. No person(s) may be under the age of 18 years old to hunt.
4. Sunday hunting must be followed in accordance with Pennsylvania Game laws.
5. Do not block access roads or park vehicles on prohibited streets.
6. HUNTERS MUST OBEY FLUORESCENT ORANGE REQUIREMENTS MANDATED BY THE PGC (Pennsylvania Game Commission).
7. Borough of St. Lawrence does not participate in the mentoring program or special junior hunting seasons.
8. Firearms, including but not limited to rifles and pistols are NOT PERMITTED for hunting. Crossbows are allowed.
9. Hunters shall observe the 150-yard safety zone for all buildings, parking lots and picnic areas. Hunters should stay 50 yds from boundaries.
10. TREE STANDS/GROUND BLINDS MUST BE TAGGED WITH NAME/PHONE NUMBER.
Climber stands are permitted.
 - Tree stands and or ground blinds may be erected no more than two (2) weeks prior to start of season.
 - Tree stands and or ground blinds must be removed no later than two (2) weeks of end of season.
 - Any tree stands and or ground blind left beyond the two (2) week limit will be subject to a \$250.00 removal fee and loss of hunting permit.
 - Any tree stands or blind not properly tagged will be removed.

- Removal fee must be paid within but no later than thirty (30) days of postmarked date. Tree stands and or ground blind will become borough property if removal fee is not paid in the thirty (30) days.
11. The sole permissible hunting is deer during archery season. No other species may be hunted on borough land.
 12. A hunting waiver and permit must be filled out every archery season at a cost determined by the borough prior to hunting on borough lands.
 13. The borough is not responsible for theft or damage to personal property.
 14. Hunter may only use public access way in and or out of hunting grounds, any other way must have private property owner consent.
 15. **Notify the Borough when a deer is harvested by no later than 2 weeks after the close of archery season. Doe tag number must be provided.**
