 Appoint Amanda Muso as Deputy Tax Collector and reappoint Allison Leinbach as Deputy Tax Collector

The elected Tax Collector, Susan Eggert of St. Lawrence, desires to appoint two deputy tax collectors to serve as tax collectors for the Borough of St. Lawrence if she is unable to perform the duties of tax collector. The Local Tax Collection Law, provides that a tax collector may, with the approval, deputize one or more deputy tax collectors. Susan Eggert desires to appoint Amanda Muso, and reappoint Allison Leinbach as Deputy Tax Collectors until the termination or resignation of either position or party.

 Variance Application for a pole barn for 3613 Stoner Ave. Reading, PA 19606, property of Adam Kraut.

He would like to build a pole barn that exceeds the dimensions allowed for a detached garage. He would like a variance of 5ft in height to allow space for a storage loft and width by 8ft to a total of a 30x40 pole barn. He is looking for a dry location for storage due to his current basement having water infiltration issues, he also does not have a current garage.
