1. Discuss accepting credit card payments and online credit card and check payments

Company called Nuvei- No cost to Borough, they handle all compliance and service fees. Credit card service fee is 4.25% per transaction ACH is \$1.99 per transaction. They include two credit card machines and all online software and website servicing. No contract, just an agreement that goes month to month.

MOTION: Approve Resolution 916-2025 Authorizing to Enter into an Agreement with The Payment Group, Nuvei and for staff to complete all necessary additional paperwork.

- 2. **MOTION**: Approve the Renewal of the Service Electric Franchise Agreement- expires March 15, 2028. Nothing will change in the renewal agreement between Service Electric and the Borough.
- 3. Discuss gas to building: UGI agreed to install a gas line in the street which will cost approx. \$63,749.00. They will pay that cost if we convert our heating systems to gas within 12 months; if we do not convert within the 12-month period the cost will then be on the Borough. Landis Mechanical submitted a quote for conversion of \$153,249.02. Cost does not include purchase or installation of a generator or restoration to the property. Options to move forward with conversion with Landis or another CoStar Contractor vs bidding out.

POTENTIAL MOTION: Approve and sign the UGI Customer Agreement to install gas lines in the public street with the intent to convert the Borough Building to Gas within 12 months
