

#### **Pilgrims of Hope for Creation**

Pilgrims of Hope for Creation is a nationwide initiative organized by nearly two dozen Catholic organizations. The initiative invites Catholics across the nation to embark on pilgrimages focused on healing and renewal deepening their relationship with God, one another, and the Earth. These pilgrimages, which can range from short walks on parish grounds to longer journeys through nature's beauty or places

of ecological significance, all share a common mission to inspire a renewed commitment to caring for creation and restoring humanity's sacred relationship with environment.

# St Cecilia's Pilgrimage of Hope for Creation Is scheduled for Sunday September $\mathbf{14}^{\text{th}}$

We will leave church at 10:30 and be back at church by 2:00 at the latest. Please save the date! We will journey to Carondelet Village (near College of St Catherine) to learn about their success at reducing fossil fuel usage with geothermal for cooling and heating. Our Pilgrimage will include transportation, music, food and time to be with our St Cecilia community. All will be family friendly.

#### A note from the Finance Committee:

We are currently working to wrap up the reporting for our fiscal year, which ended on June 30, 2025. Thanks to your support, we exceeded our budget projections for operating revenues. Envelope and plate revenues increased 18% from 2024. In addition, our parish dinner contributed almost \$30,000 in net revenue. We also managed our expenses effectively (an increase of 4% from last year), resulting in an operating surplus. We also received an estate bequest during the year of \$39,000 (net). We used building fund contributions, a transfer from our permanent endowment and building fund reserves to fund over \$45,000 in building improvements during the year. Our cash and investment balances are strong, and we have no outstanding debt. We will provide a full update on the final results later this summer when the yearend close process is complete. Your ongoing support of the parish is appreciated!
