

Financial Results for the Nine Months ended March 31, 2025

Actual Operating Revenues \$325,323 Anticipated Operating Revenues\$270,500

Actual Operating Expenses \$295,763 Anticipated Operating Expenses\$319,000

Excess Revenues over Expense \$29,560 Building Contributions \$10,602 Bequests, net \$39,121 Building Expenditures (\$45,245)

Total Surplus \$34,038

Through nine months of our fiscal year we have a total surplus of \$34,038. The surplus results from stronger than expected contributions (including a bequest gift), prudent expense management and an insurance recovery related to the roof replacement. Thank you for your continued support of the parish, particularly the upcoming Parish Celebration, as we wrap up our fiscal year.

#### Food Drive-June 14th/15th

Summer break is right around the corner and that means that children who benefit from meals at school may go hungry. While all types of nonperishable food is needed, we will focus on kid-friendly food and personal care items.

Nonperishable food:

- Low sugar fruit juices (individual boxes or pouches)
- Low sugar individual fruit cups and canned fruit
- Microwaveable individual pasta meals, soup, etc.
- Canned vegetables, canned stew, chili, soup, tuna
- Low sugar cereal and breakfast bars, individual oatmeal packets
- Pasta and spaghetti sauce
- Crackers and healthy snacks (Goldfish crackers, Cheez-its, etc.)
- Peanut butter and jelly
- Cake mixes and frosting (for summer birthdays)

#### Personal care items:

- Toothbrushes and toothpaste
- Bar soap/body wash
- Deodorant
- Shampoo and conditioner
- Brushes and combs
