Lectio Divina

"Deepening communion with God is the invitation and adventure of our lives. We want it, and we are looking for methods that will help us realize it. We must have an *experience* of God if we are to pursue God with our whole heart, mind, and soul. Intellectual knowledge *about* God will not be enough to feed us and hold us. *Lectio divina* is an accessible way to have such an encounter." - Thomas Ryan, CSP *Living the Eucharist*, Paulist Evangelization Ministries, 2013

"The Church desires that in the ministry of the word, Sacred Scripture should have a pre-eminent position. In concrete terms, catechesis should be 'an authentic introduction to lectio divina, that is, to a reading of the Sacred Scriptures done in accordance to the Spirit who dwells in the Church'." - General Directory for Catechesis, 71

"The Latin words *lectio divina*, which mean 'divine reading' or 'spiritual reading,' refer to slow, meditative reading of a passage from Scripture. It is a form of prayer that focuses on listening and responding to God's word."

Four Steps

There is no standard way of doing *lectio divina*, but the following method has proven helpful to beginners.

- 1. Read (*Lectio*): Read a passage from Scripture. 'Listen' to God's word. Gather the facts. Does a particular word or phrase speak to you?
- 2. Reflect (*Meditatio*): Read the passage again. Reflect on the passage as a whole or on a particular phrase. What is God saying to you?
- 3. Respond (*Oratio*): Read the Scripture once again. Respond to God with your heart. What do you want to say to God?
- 4. Rest (*Contemplatio*): Read the selection a final time. Rest in God's presence for a few minutes.
