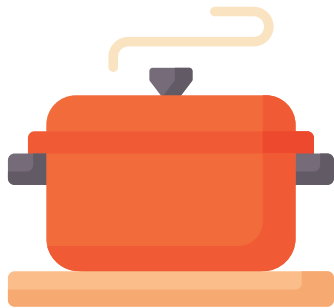
Date: Sunday, June 7
