Psalm 66. Let all the earth cry out in joy to the Lord.

Galatians 6: 14-18. Paul boasts only of the cross of Jesus and bears the brand marks of Jesus in his body. Each one is to be created anew.

Luke 10: 1-12, 17-20. Jesus sent forth the 72 disciples to announce that the reign of God is at hand. Upon their return, they are told to rejoice that their names are inscribed in heaven.
