

Third Sunday of Easter C

Acts 5:27-32, 40-41. The apostles respond to the High Priest and the Sanhedrin: God has raised up Jesus whom you put to death. So too does the Holy Spirit testify to this. The Sanhedrin, however, before dismissing the apostles has them whipped. The apostles rejoiced to have been judged worthy of ill-treatment for the sake of the Name.

Psalm 30. I will praise you, Lord, you have rescued me.

Revelation 5:11-14. In a vision of heaven, John heard the voices of many angels, crying out “Worthy is the lamb that was slain to receive power and riches, wisdom and strength, honor and glory and praise.

John 21:1-19. A miraculous haul of fishes, Jesus prepares a meal and eats with his disciples, the solemn commissioning of Peter and the prediction that he will die a martyr.
