

- We will journey to Carondelet Village (near College of St Catherine) to learn about their success at reducing fossil fuel usage with geothermal for cooling and heating.
- Our Pilgrimage will include transportation, music, food and time to be with our St Cecilia's community
- There will be a fully accessible option for those who do not wish to do any walking. Carondelet Village is a beautifully accessible facility with elevators, etc.
- All will be family friendly

- -We will leave directly after Mass
- -We will carpool the 4 miles to St Catherine's parking lot (maps and directions provided)
- -A short pilgrimage walk through The Rain Garden at Carondelet Village with song and prayer to celebrate creation. A "no walking option" as well!
- -We will learn a little about the Geothermal at Carondelet Village
- -We will share a light meal together and
- express our concern to St Paul Officials in writing, urging bold action
- -We will be done at 1:45 at Carondelet and back to St Cecilia's before 2:00
