
#### **Parish Event**

#### Prayer:

Heavenly Father,

As we gather on this Third Sunday of Easter, we are reminded of Your boundless mercy and love for all creation. Grant us the grace to recognize Jesus Christ as the source of life and renewal, just as Peter proclaimed to the people. Help us to repent and be converted, turning away from the sins that harm both humanity and the Earth, so that Your forgiveness may bring about healing and restoration.
