Second Sunday of Lent

Genesis 22:1-2, 9, 10-13,15-18. On the assumption that God wanted the sacrifice of his only son, Isaac, Abraham proceeds to the ritual act of child sacrifice.. God blesses Abraham for his willingness to go to such extremes out of obedience to the Lord's will and out of faith in the future.

Psalm 116. Our blessing cup is a communion with the Blood of the Lord.

Romans 8:31b-34. God did not spare his own son for our sake. Who can bring a charge against us?

Mark 9:2-10. Jesus' transfiguration and the first assignment of his death and resurrection.
