

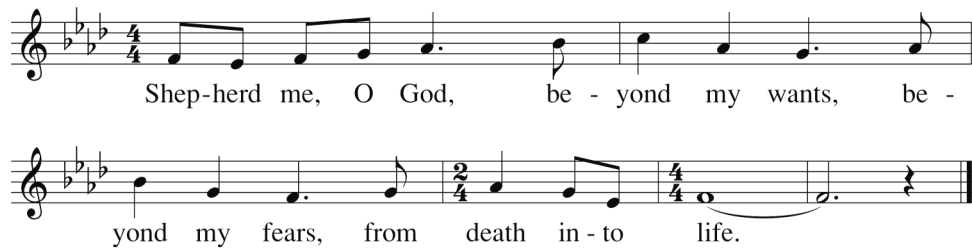

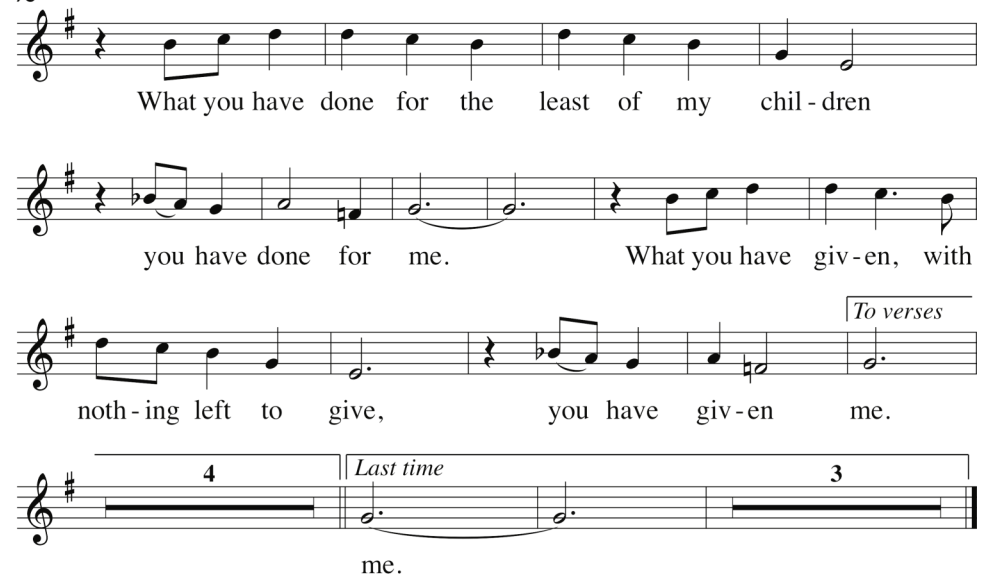

trusting that in your mercy you have sheltered me.

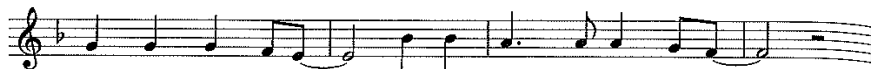

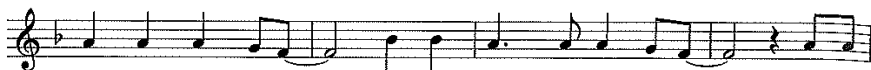
