

No eye had seen, no ear had heard All to be found in God's own Word Till, rending heaven, Christ was born To dwell with us who were forlorn.


Our wand'ring ways and hardened hearts Refused the truth God's law imparts. Like withered leaves before a gale Our sinful selves, uncentered, sailed.




