

Twenty-fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time C

Amos 8:4-7. Condemnation of social injustices which trample upon the needy.

Psalm 113. Praise the Lord, praise the Lord who lifts up the poor.

1 Timothy 2:1-8. Prayers are requested for peace, peace with those in authority, between races and nations, among the disciples of Jesus, just as there is peace between God the Father, the mediator Jesus and the entire human family.

Luke 1:1-13. The parable of the wily steward, more ingenious about worldly goods than the other-worldly, is about spiritual concerns. A number of proverbs about wealth and stewardship are added.
