

Through nine months of our fiscal year we have a total surplus of \$34,038. The surplus results from stronger than expected contributions (including a bequest gift), prudent expense management and an insurance recovery related to the roof replacement. - Peanut butter and jelly
- Cake mixes and frosting (for summer birthdays)

Personal care items:

- Toothbrushes and toothpaste
- Bar soap/body wash

- Brushes and combs
