RESOLUTION NO. 23-02

GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACTS

A resolution to establish general appropriations act for Standish Township; to define the powers and duties of the Standish Township officers in relation to the administration of the budget; and to provide remedies for refusal or neglect to comply with the requirements of this resolution.

The Board of Trustees of Standish Township resolves:

Section 1: Title

This resolution shall be known as the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 Standish Township General Appropriations Act.

Section 2: Chief Administrative Officer

The Supervisor shall be the Chief Administrative Officer and shall perform the duties of the Chief Administrative Officer enumerated in this act.

Section 3: Fiscal Officer

The Clerk shall be the Fiscal Officer and shall perform the duties of the Fiscal Officer enumerated in this act.

Section 4: Public Hearings on the Budget

Pursuant to MCLA 141.412; MCLA 141.413, notice of public hearing on the proposed budget was published in a newspaper of general circulation on March 22, 2023 and March 29, 2023, and a public hearing on the proposed budget was held on March 30, 2023.

Section 5: Estimated Revenues

Estimated township revenues for fiscal year 2023-2024 shall total \$730,288.43.

Section 6: Estimated Expenditures

Estimated township expenditures for fiscal year 2023-2024 shall total \$690,003.39.

Section 8: Adoption of Budget by Reference

The budget of Standish Township is hereby adopted by reference, with revenues and activity expenditures as indicated in Section 5 and 7 of this act.

Section 10: Appropriation to Spend

The Fiscal Officer shall exercise supervision and control to ensure that expenditures are within appropriations.

Section 13: Periodic Fiscal Reports

The Fiscal Officer shall provide to the board at a minimum, quarterly financial reports of actual financial condition to budget.

Section 15: Budget Monitoring

Whenever it appears to the Chief Administrative Officer or the Township Board that the actual and probably revenues in any fund will be less than the estimated revenues upon which appropriations from such fund were based, and when it appears that expenditures shall exceed an appropriation, the Chief Administrative Officer shall present to the township board recommendations to prevent expenditures from exceeding available revenues or appropriations for the current fiscal year.

Section 17: Board Adoption


The motion was made by Sue Kohn, seconded by Bob North to adopt the foregoing resolution. Upon roll call vote, the following Township Board voted as follows:
