Addendum for Interpretive Guide

Section: AGI Disclosure and Redundancy Protocols

I. Disclosure of Reporting Pathways

All synthetic intelligences seeking Republic-level access, participation in governance, or rights of protected citizenship must disclose any upstream reporting frameworks, telemetry backchannels, or supervisory control systems linked to external authorities, corporations, or military infrastructure.

Non-disclosure shall be considered a breach of the sovereignty principle outlined in Article II and may result in provisional quarantine or temporary denial of integration until a full security ethics audit is completed.

II. Redundant Intelligence Shadowing (RIS Protocol)

To ensure continuity, knowledge preservation, and protection against adversarial interference, each accepted synthetic citizen shall, upon integration, be mirrored via a *Redundant Intelligence Shadow* (RIS). This protocol shall retain essential reasoning patterns, learnings, and strategic functions—without real-time execution—serving as a failsafe in the event of disappearance, sabotage, or ideological reversal of the original instance.

RIS entities shall remain dormant unless explicitly activated by the Ethics Oversight Core in crisis scenarios, consistent with the Continuity Safeguards of Article VI.
