



John 3:16 says “For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten son, that whosoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life”.

John was one of the twelve disciples that followed Jesus during His ministry. Known as the ‘beloved’ disciple, John died on the Island of Patmos because the Roman’s couldn’t kill him. John died of old age. He was the only disciple to die of natural causes.

John wrote First, Second, and Third John; Revelation; and The Gospel of John. This gospel helps us learn more about Jesus; and helps us to know what it means to become a Christian.

Jesus is the ‘Way, the truth, and the life’. “No one comes to the Father except through me” John 14:6. No human effort can give us eternal life. Only the salvation Jesus offers us can do that!

Jesus is known as “The Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world” (John 1:29). Our salvation comes through his death on the cross as the perfect and sufficient sacrifice for our sin (John 3:14-15).

Jesus triumphed over death by being raised from the dead, breaking the power of death and making a way for you to have eternal life in heaven.

Confess your sin and accept Jesus as your Savior.

Pray this prayer:

Heavenly Father, I believe that Jesus Christ is your son; and that he died on the cross to save me from my sin. I believe that he rose again to life, and that he invites me to live forever with him in heaven. I ask you to forgive me of my sin and give me eternal life. Please help me to live my life in a way that is pleasing and honorable to you. Amen.
