League Nights – Every Other Friday (4/25, 5/9, 5/23, 6/6, 6/20, 7/18, 8/1) – Closed 7/4 for Holiday

League Duration – 7 Weeks

Registration Close Date – April 23rd

Start Date – April 25th

End Date – August 1st

Tournament – No Date Scheduled

Number of Teams – 24 Teams Max

Game Times – Games begin @ 6:30pm – Last game 8:30pm – 20 minute games

Games Played – Multiple Games per night – See Schedule

Teams Eligible – Men's – Women's – Co-Ed – 2 Person Teams

League Fee - \$80/Team – To be paid **NO LATER THAN** first night.

League Payback – 100% Payout – Payout based on number of league teams. Payout will be based on the number of wins you earn during the regular season and First Place to Last Place receives money for the league.

Substitutions/Absence – It is **YOUR** responsibility to obtain a sub. **Substitute players can only sub on one team per league night.**

Please keep in mind that not only is it irresponsible not to show up just because you don't want to, it is also very inconsiderate of your playing partners and creates complete havoc with the scheduling, standings, games, etc. Please be courteous and obtain a sub if needed.

League Schedule – Will be provided opening night and available on our website (<https://haasports.org>), facebook page or bags league facebook page.

The schedule will also be available at start of each league night thereafter.

Start of Game – Coin Toss – Winner of coin toss starts game. Winner picks side **OR** bag color. Partners line up directly across from each other in the same lane, not diagonally across from each other in opposite lane.

Scoring – Cancellation play – Points 21 **OR OVER** – Finish round of play (No skunk rule, No bust rule)

Scoring Points – In the Hole = 3 – On Board = 1

Recording Match Results - Teams will be provided with a score sheet each week. Each team must record the game winner (circle team name) and point totals each night. **You are responsible to turn in your score sheet at the end of the night.** Please know that if this is not done, each team will be given a loss as it cannot be the responsibility of the league secretary to guess who won or lost. Keep in mind it is also a loss of point money and potentially a position in the standings if you actually won the game.

Forfeited Games – Teams that do not show up or obtain subs will automatically lose their games. The opposing team will record the win and be awarded 21 points.

Wins & Losses – Will be documented each week. In the case of any league ties at seasons end, the tie breaker will be based on points allowed differential.

Standings – Will be updated each week and posted on our website, facebook page and bags league facebook page

Rainouts – Games will be played under the pavilion

Boards & Bags – Provided by H.A.A.A. Must use H.A.A.A. bags only!! No personal bags are allowed.

AMERICAN CORNHOLE
ORGANIZATION

ACO **OFFICIAL RULES** FOR THE SPORT OF CORNHOLE

Boards are placed **27 feet** from front edge to front edge.

Games are played to **21 or more points**. (no bust)

Woody: Refers to any cornhole bag that has been pitched and remains on the cornhole board playing surface at the conclusion of the frame. **Each woody is 1pt.**

Cornhole: Refers to any cornhole bag that has been pitched and passes through the cornhole board hole at anytime within the frame. **Each cornhole is 3pts.**

A bag that comes to rest touching the ground AND the board does not count as a point.

Cancellation Scoring: The approved method of scoring for the sport of cornhole is "cancellation" scoring. In cancellation scoring, the points of one player cancel out the points of their opponent. Using this method, only one player/team can score in each frame.

Both players **play one board at a time** and **stay in their designated lane** for the whole game (right or left).

Players start the game at one board and **alternate pitching bags** until each player has pitched all (4) of their bags.

Players then **walk to the end of their lane** to the other board, take score, and resume pitching back to the other cornhole board.

Players must deliver the bag with an **underhanded release**.

Feet must stay **behind the line of the front of the board** at the time of releasing the bag.

The player/team who scored in the preceding frame **pitches first** in the next frame.

If neither player/team scores, the player/team who pitched first in the preceding frame shall retain first pitch in the next frame.

If bags become piled inside the hole and may interfere or obstruct with the next pitch or if there is question whether a cornhole bag would have naturally fallen through the hole, a player may request to **rake** the cornhole bags that have fallen inside the hole.
