## QUALIFICATIONS

1. Must be a legal resident in the Greater Long Beach Realm
  - a. Cities of Artesia, Bellflower, Carson, Cerritos, Compton, Downey, Gardena, Lakewood, Lomita, Long Beach, Lynwood, Paramount, Rancho Palos Verdes, Rolling Hills & the communities of Harbor City, San Pedro & Wilmington
2. Must be at least 21 years of age
3. Must have a valid ID Card
4. Must be invested in the past two consecutive reigns
5. Must attach an annual calendar of events for the duration of the reign in which you are asking to be considered
6. Must submit a personal statement detailing why you would like to run for the position of Emperor, Empress or Emprex (500 word maximum)
7. Return completed application to [Empress.Brenda@IICLB.org](mailto:Empress.Brenda@IICLB.org) not later than 5pm on January 16, 2024
8. Submit Filing Fee in the amount of \$100 – Cash, Venmo or PayPal ONLY

## EXPECTATIONS

1. If you are elected to your position, you will be in charge of the Fundraising Committee
  2. Attend events throughout the Realm as well as at neighboring Imperial Court chapters
  3. Attend the following required Coronations: Los Angeles/Hollywood, San Diego & Las Vegas
  4. Attend four (4) out of state Coronations
  5. Attend a minimum of 85% of all IICLB hosted events
  6. Attend the Mayor's Reception & Pink Party
- \*Attendance may be required for other events pending Board approval

## CAMPAIGN RULES

1. All candidates must attend the Candidate Announcement Event Jan 20, 2024
2. No campaigning or declaration of candidacy may take place prior to the Candidate Announcement Event
3. All campaign fundraisers, including private events, must clearly identify the purpose for which the funds are raised
4. No destroying or defacing the campaign literature of other candidates
5. No negative campaigning against any other candidate
6. Violation of any of these rules will result in the immediate termination of your candidacy

## VOTING RULES

1. Each candidate is allowed one (1) vote monitor of their choosing, to be present during the voting process. The candidate must inform the Board of Directors who their monitor will be, no later than three (3) days before the election.
2. There will be no campaigning within 25 feet of the voting location
3. No candidate will be allowed to staff or monitor the voting room
4. Voting location will be announced no later than thirty (30) days prior to election
