Please submit a total of three (3) letters of recommendation. Two (1) should come from academic sources and the additional one (2) should come from a personal source. Please use the following prompts when drafting your letter.

- 1. How long have you known the applicant?
- 2. In what capacity?
- 3. What leadership qualities come to mind when you think about the applicant?
- 4. Why should we select this applicant for the 2024 United Waves Scholarship?

The winner (s) of this round of scholarships will be selected by a committee vote and will be announced on May 11, 2024 and the scholarship will be awarded for the Fall 2024 semester. All decisions are final. Dates subject to change.
