- Please know, we do our VERY best to ensure that your swimmer has the same instructor for all eight lessons. However, our instructors have families of their own, they get sick and they do get to take vacations! We will provide a substitute teacher if this happens.
- Classes with fewer than 3 participants will be cancelled. You will be contacted the Friday prior to the class starting if this occurs. The class may be combined with a similar level or you may choose to upgrade the lesson to a private lesson and pay the difference.
- All classes are 30 minutes in length. There will be no discounts or refunds for missed classes.
- If you miss a class due to personal reasons, we will not offer a make up class or partial refund or class credit.
- If your family becomes too ill to participate in class, alert us as soon as possible to make other arrangements. This could include switching your registration to a later date, pro-rated refund or alternative option.
- If the Molalla Aquatic Center has to close or cancel a class, a make up class will be provided.
- Registration will open on August 29, 2022. Please ensure that your account is up to date!
