

A Resolution addressing Unlawful Conduct During a 9-1-1 Call Committee: Social and Economic Justice Resolution: SEJ-20-06

- 1. WHEREAS To amend all official codes relating to offenses against public order, so as
- 2. to revise the offense of unlawful conduct during 9-1-1 callS to include bias motivations in
- 3. calling or otherwise contacting 9-1-1;
- 4. WHEREAS to provide for a criminal penalty; to amend state Official Codes, relating to
- 5. general provisions regarding torts, so as to provide for a cause of action against persons
- 6. who knowingly cause a peace officer to arrive at a location, owing to false reporting or
- 7. bias purposes;
- 8. WHEREAS to provide for definitions; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 9. conflicting laws; and for other purposes.
- 10. THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the NOBEL Women fully supports providing
- 11. criminal penalty to any person who calls 9-1-1 to initiate false reports;
- 12. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that NOBEL WOMEN urges local, state, and federal
- 13. lawmakers to draft legislation to provide criminal penalty for individuals who knowing
- 14. calls 9-1-1 to submit a false report; and
- 15. **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, that a copy of this resolution be transmitted to the
- 16. President of the United States, the Vice President of the United States, members of the
- 17. United States House of Representatives and the United States Senate, Governors, and
- 18. other federal and state government officials and agencies as appropriate.
