

## A Resolution Addressing Preschool Dismissal

COMMITTEE: Education RESOLUTION: EDU-20-02

- 1. WHEREAS, a pupil enrolled in a preschool or pre kindergarten program, including a
- 2. child participating in early childhood family education, school readiness, school readiness
- 3. plus, voluntary prekindergarten, Head Start, or other school-based preschool or
- 4. prekindergarten program may not be subject to dismissals. Expulsions and exclusions
- 5. may be used only after resources as outlined in the following clause have been exhausted,
- 6. and only in circumstances where there is an ongoing serious safety threat to the child or
- 7. others; and
- 8. WHEREAS, a school district or charter school must ensure that a pupil described in the
- 9. previous clause fully participates in a preschool or pre kindergarten program described in
- 10. the previous clause by providing one or more of the following services: collaborating
- 11. with the pupil's family or guardian, child mental health consultant or provider, education
- 12. specialist, or other community-based support;
- 13. (2) creating a plan, written with the parent or guardian, that details the action and support
- 14. needed for the pupil to fully participate in a preschool or pre kindergarten program;
- 15. (3) providing a referral for needed support services, including parenting education, home
- 16. visits, or other supportive educational interventions; or
- 17. (4) an evaluation to determine if the pupil is eligible for special education services or
- 18. section 504 services.
- 19. **BE IT RESOLVED** that NOBEL Women assert that there should be full and equitable
- 20. participation in preschool and prekindergarten programs in the United States of America.
