



HISTORY

Through the efforts of Republican activists **Donna Bloxom** and **Olive Milgate**, the Republican Women's Organization was formed by 20 women from Worcester County and **founded on July 16, 1984**. Bylaws were adopted, and dues were set. Nineteen women joined on the first day, and the twentieth, a former Democrat, joined after changing party affiliation. **Olive Milgate** was elected the first President.

The Republican Women of Worcester County (RWWC) was chartered as a branch of the Maryland Federation of Republican Women and the National Federation of Republican Women. Its goal was to provide women of Worcester County with the opportunity to unite and play an active role in the Republican Party.
